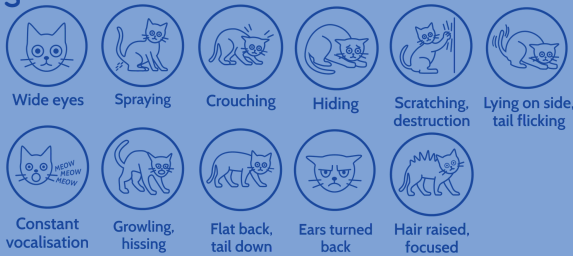


Stress & Your Pet

What Is SettlePet™?

How SettlePet™ Works

SettlePet™ contains Lactium®. Lactium® is a natural ingredient consisting of a milk protein hydrolysate which contains a bioactive decapeptide called alpha-casozepine.

Lactium® has relaxing properties and reduces anxiety symptoms in pets. It works in a similar way to babies feeling relaxed after milk feedings by sending calming messages to the brain. Alpha-casozepine binds to receptors in the brain to reduce excitement and naturally calm the pet during stressful or unusual situations.



Alpha-casozapine has also been shown to reduce the incidence of lower urinary tract disease in cats that may be associated with stress.*
