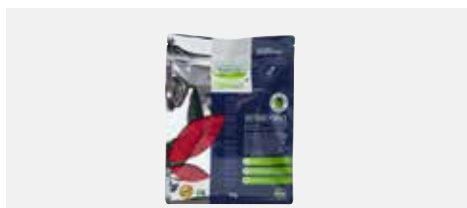

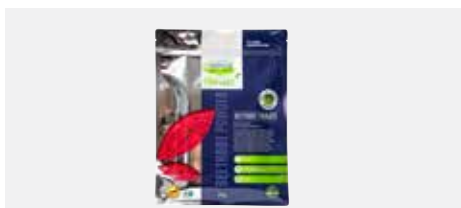

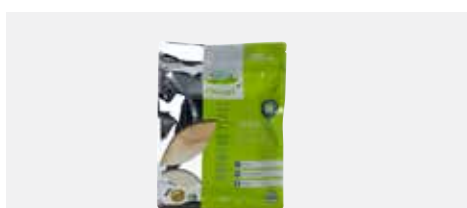

Ponies: 15g to 30g per day in food, or as directed by your veterinarian.

Dogs: 2.5g per 10kg bodyweight added to food or as directed by your veterinarian.

Greyhounds: 2 teaspoons per every 1kg of food being fed, or as directed by your veterinarian.

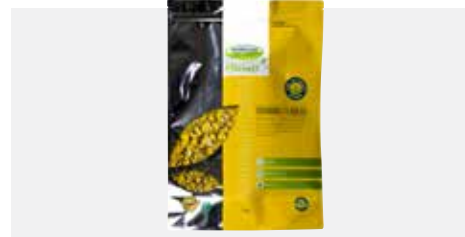

GENERAL FEEDING GUIDE	Horses: A handful of dried flowers (15-20g) or a cup of strained tea added to your horse's morning and afternoon feed or as directed by your veterinarian.
	Dogs: Dried flowers- 250mg to 500mg per 10kg bodyweight, ideally divided over 2 to 3 feeds daily or as directed by your veterinarian.

Garlic Granules *Allium sativum*

Garlic (*Allium sativum*) is a species of bulbous flowering plant in the onion genus *Allium*.

Crooked Lane Garlic Granules are 100% dehydrated garlic prepared from fresh, mature and cleaned wholesome bulb of the perennial plant varieties of *Allium sativum* L. which have been washed, cleaned, hot air dried, sliced and milled. Garlic is well known as a feed material for optimum good health, especially the immune, respiratory and digestive systems. It has also been stated that garlic supplementation may act as a natural fly repellent.

GENERAL FEEDING GUIDE

Horses: 4g to 7.5g added to food, or as directed by your veterinarian.

Ponies: 1.5g to 3g added to food, or as directed by your veterinarian.

According to the National Research Council (2009), an average 450-500kg horse can conservatively consume 7.5 grams of garlic per day. In these amounts, studies have shown garlic supplementation was unlikely to result in horses developing anaemia, even if they consume garlic long term.

Psyllium Husk *Plantago ovato*

Psyllium is a fibre bulking agent, when combined with water it swells to many times its original size, becoming slimy and gelatinous. For horses, when fed psyllium husk, it has the ability to pick up sand and move it through the gut.

Crooked Lane Harvest Psyllium Husk is Premium Human Food Grade. Psyllium Husk is a popular source of fibre for both humans and pets. It is a safe, easy to use ingredient that can be added to the food. Psyllium fibre dietary supplements are used in veterinary medicine to aid in elimination of sand from the horse's colon.

If your horse is grazing in dry/drought conditions or is housed in a dry or a sandy yard or paddock, feeding psyllium husk monthly may help to remove sand and dirt from the hindgut.

Horses: Mix well in slightly dampened feed. To improve palatability, try mixing Psyllium Husk with molasses to make a crumble and spread over feed.

Horses: Maintenance- 125g to 250g for two to five consecutive days added to food or as directed by your veterinarian.

Horses: High risk - 250g for two to five consecutive days added to food or as directed by your veterinarian.

Dogs and Cats: 1/2 to 1 teaspoon for 10kg bodyweight added to food or as directed by your veterinarian.

Med Sized Dogs: 1/2 to 1 teaspoon daily added to food or as directed by your veterinarian.

Large Size Dogs: 1-2 teaspoons daily added to food or as directed by your veterinarian.

Dogs & Cats: 160-320mg ($\frac{1}{16}$ to $\frac{1}{8}$ teaspoon) per 10kg bodyweight added to food or as directed by your veterinarian.

Slippery Elm Bark Powder *Ulmus Rubra*

Ulmus rubra, the slippery elm, is a species of elm native to eastern North America.
