

TOILET TRAINING KITTENSA QUICK GUIDE

How to toilet train your kitten is an important step in ensuring their comfort and maintaining a clean household.



Choose the right location

Ensure it's away from the kitten's food and water, and in a location where they feel safe and secure. A good place is either the laundry or a small room.

What you need

Cat litter tray: Choose a shallow, easily accessible litter tray for your kitten. Consider if you need a standard tray or a sieve tray to separate used litter

Litter: Use a non-clumping, unscented litter that is safe for kittens. i.e wood pellet cat litter or paper litter

Cat litter scoop: A litter scoop to clean the litter box regularly.

Cleaning Supplies: Have enzyme cleaning products and litter tray deodorisers on hand to clean any accidents.



Keep It Clean

Scoop out waste daily to keep the litter box clean and odour-free. Completely change the litter and clean the box with mild soap and water once a week. An ecofriendly litter tray deodoriser will assist to eliminate odour-forming bacteria and germs.
